**EB-2010-0058 – Proposed Amendments to the Transmission System Code regarding the definition of “Supporting Guarantee” – Comments from Hydro One Networks Inc.**

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Hydro One Networks Inc. (“Hydro One”) welcomes the Ontario Energy Board’s (the “Board’s”) proposed amendments to the definition of “Supporting Guarantee” in the Transmission System Code (the “TSC”). Hydro One believes that the alignment of the definitions in the TSC and the Utility Work Protection Code (the “UWPC”) will contribute to a clear and consistent understanding of the obligations by all parties. This will provide a safer work environment for utility staff, customers and the public, as well as enhance the protection of power systems equipment.

We would like to take this opportunity to also clarify that the UWPC definition does not actually require a written guarantee of a particular state or condition. The analysis of section 27.7.1 in Appendix A of our letter to the Board, dated February 26, 2010, which stated that the party requesting a Supporting Guarantee would receive a *document* from the issuing party, should have instead read that the requesting party would receive a *confirmation* from the issuing party.

Hydro One looks forward to working with customers to implement these proposed amendments.
