**Re: Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited (“Toronto Hydro”)
OEB File No. EB-2012-0064 (the “Application”)**

The purpose of this letter is to make the OEB and parties to the above-noted proceeding aware of efforts by Toronto Hydro-Electric System (“Toronto Hydro”) to address the updating of evidence that has been filed in the proceeding.

Toronto Hydro’s application, of course, encompasses the three-year period from 2012 to 2014 and, more specifically, its Incremental Capital Module (“ICM”) application seeks approval of proposed capital expenditures in each of the years 2012, 2013 and 2014.

Given that it is now September of 2012, Toronto Hydro acknowledges that much of 2012 will likely already have passed by the time that the evidentiary phase of this proceeding has concluded. Accordingly, Toronto Hydro is undertaking a review of the extent to which the work proposed in the ICM application, and especially that for 2012, needs to be updated and re-prioritized to take account of the reality that an OEB decision in respect of the first year’s proposed capital spending will not be available until late in this year or early 2013.

Toronto Hydro has not yet completed this review of the work proposed in the ICM application, but at the earliest possible opportunity after the review has been completed, Toronto Hydro will file its update to the evidence with the OEB. Toronto Hydro will write to the OEB and intervenors regarding the specific date on which it intends to file its update as soon as it is in a position to do so.

Toronto Hydro acknowledges that the filing of an update may necessitate further procedural steps, and respectfully requests that the OEB await the filing of this update before considering what procedural steps, if any, may be appropriate in light of the updated evidence. In the meantime, interrogatories on the pre-filed evidence are due on September 14, 2012 and Toronto Hydro’s completion of its review of

the need for updating of the evidence will proceed concurrently with work on the interrogatories. Toronto Hydro's interrogatory responses will reflect the most current information available.
