**Reasons why costs should be awarded**

RCC submitted its Request for Participant Status and Cost Award Eligibility on August 7, 2012 and was found eligible in these respects by the Board in its Decision on Cost Eligibility dated August 20, 2012.

RCC represents Ontario and Canada's retail sectors; members account for 80% of total retail sales in the country. RCC members form a broad base of electricity consumers and have an important stake in issues relating to the efficient pricing of electricity generated by OPG and, by extension, incentive regulation as it applies to OPG's unique circumstances.

RCC participated responsibly in the Consultation and avoided duplication by focusing on how the matters covered in the combined consultation may affect retailers as rate-payers.
