Re: EB-2012-0064 - Toronto IRM/ICM Phase 2 - SEC Cost Claim

We are counsel for the School Energy Coalition. We enclose the cost claim of the School Energy Coalition, on the Board's form and enclosing docket details.

This case was unusual in that a lot of the higher level issues had been addressed in Phase 1, but there were still substantial technical and "year over year" details, and a lot of proposed capital spending, at issue for 2014. Further, the focus in this case was a very challenging ADR process which, while ultimately a complete success, was more difficult than either the Board or the parties expected. This can be seen by the delays in filing the Settlement Agreement, despite an in-person negotiation of only two days.

SEC's approach to this proceeding was to give initial case control to Mark Rubenstein, who was also the lead in Phase 1. As can be seen from the dockets, almost all of the work on this matter up until the ADR was done by Mr. Rubenstein. The role of senior counsel Jay Shepherd was limited to a supervisory one, and client reporting.

As it became clear that the ADR would have more complexities than had originally been expected, and that SEC would be asked by the parties to take a leadership role in that process, Mr. Shepherd's role increased, and his hours related to the ADR reflect that necessity. Again as disclosed in the dockets, the main bulk of the time was still spent by Mr. Rubenstein, but Mr.

Shepherd started participating in intervenor caucuses and direct negotiations with the utility, and took an active role in the drafting process. With the exception of 2.4 hours up to and including the Technical Conference, essentially all of Mr. Shepherd's time was to do with the ADR (and related communications with the client).

It is submitted that the resulting time balance between senior counsel and junior counsel was effective, and helped the parties produce a good result while keeping the overall cost of the SEC intervention low. Mr. Shepherd did not have to invest fifty hours or more working through the details of the evidence, asking interrogatories, and the like, but when his experience was of assistance to the process towards the end, he had the support of a knowledgeable junior counsel fully conversant with all of the facts.
