AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Hydro One Networks Inc. seeking changes to the electricity transmission revenue requirement for 2015 and 2016 to be effective January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

November 10, 2014

Hydro One Networks Inc. ("Hydro One") filed a complete cost of service application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 16, 2014 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the electricity transmission revenue requirement for 2015 and 2016 to be effective January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016. Hydro One also submitted a proposed comprehensive settlement agreement that it reached with ratepayer and other groups that participated in Hydro One's last transmission rate hearing (EB-2012-0031).

The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2014-0140.

A Notice of Application and Hearing ("Notice") was issued on October 14, 2014.

Each of the following groups applied for intervenor status: London Property Management Association, ("LPMA"), the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC"), School Energy Coalition ("SEC"), Power Workers Union ("PWU"), Ontario Power Generation ("OPG"), HQ Energy Marketing Inc. ("HQEM"), Holcim Canada Inc. ("Holcim"), the Building Owners and Managers Association, Greater Toronto ("BOMA"),

Society of Energy Professionals (“SEP”), Association of Power Producers of Ontario (“APPRO”), Energy Probe Research Foundation (“Energy Probe”) and the Independent Electricity System Operator (“IESO”). The Board notes that Energy Probe applied after the intervention deadline. LPMA, VECC, SEC, BOMA, APPRO and Energy Probe also applied for cost eligibility.

I approve LPMA, VECC, SEC, PWU, OPG, HQEM, Holcim, BOMA, SEP, APPRO, Energy Probe and IESO as intervenors. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this Procedural Order. I have also determined that LPMA, VECC, SEC, BOMA, APPRO and Energy Probe are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board’s *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

Cost eligible intervenors should be aware that the Board will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party, unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed.

I consider it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Board directs all intervenors who were not a party to the Settlement Agreement to file a letter informing the Board of their position on the Agreement. The letter must be filed on or before **November 17, 2014**, and must clearly state whether the specific party supports, opposes or takes no position on the Agreement filed by Hydro One. If a party opposes the Agreement, it must provide reasons for its position.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2014-0140, be made electronically through the Board’s web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>, in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Two paper copies must also be filed at the Board’s address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender’s name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available

parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
