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1. Residential Rate Design Chapter 3.2.3

Atikokan used the Bill Impact Sheet #18 in the 2016 IRM Rate Generator Model. During Atikokan's last Cost of Service in 2012, it was determined that 581 kWh was the average Residential consumption. This is the scenario Atikokan has chosen to present the percentile change for the 2016 rates.

Atikokan has chosen a 2 year transition period to be within the \$4.00 impact. The bill impact for all Residential customers to a fixed service charge shows an increase of \$3.95. Based on the 1.65% GDPIPI monthly service charge increase would be \$0.64.

The total bill impact for RPP Residential shows a difference (3.48%) prior to taxes and OCEB. This is within the 10% threshold.

The Non-RPP Residential shows a difference of 2.44% prior to taxes and OCEB. This is within the 10% threshold.

The differences between the RPP and Non-RPP residential rates are the Deferral /Variance Account Rate Riders. Non-RPP customers are paying the Global Adjustment Rate Rider. Non-RPP customers are also required to pay Global Adjustment price based on their consumption.

As a result of the Bill Impacts Atikokan is not proposing any mitigation measures for residential customers.
