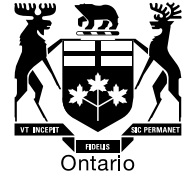

**Re: Request for intervenor status

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) is in receipt of your letter dated August 28, 2017 in which you request intervenor status and cost award eligibility in the referenced application. The OEB has also received a letter from Oshawa PUC Networks Inc., objecting to your request for intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

In your letter of intervention you note that you are "...requesting intervenor status on behalf of my small business and as a representative/advocate for other small business owners in the Greater Niagara Chamber of Commerce and Ontario Chamber of Commerce".

The OEB requires the following information in respect of your request for intervention:

- Mandate and objectives of Capredoni Enterprises Ltd.
- Types of programs or activities that Capredoni Enterprises Ltd. carries out
- Proof that Capredoni Enterprises Ltd. is authorized to represent small business owners in the Greater Niagara Chamber of Commerce and Ontario Chamber of Commerce, including the basis for the appointment and manner of obtaining instructions
- Description of the interests and concerns of the members of the Greater Niagara Chamber of Commerce as they relate to the issues in Oshawa PUC Networks Inc.'s application

- Confirmation that Capredoni Enterprises Ltd. and any other organizations it represents are customers of Oshawa PUC Networks Inc.

Please provide the requested information by **September 22, 2017**. If the OEB does not receive the requested information by **September 22, 2017**, the OEB will proceed in this matter on the basis of the information that you have provided in your original letter of intervention.

The OEB notes that the Greater Oshawa Chamber of Commerce has previously intervened in Oshawa PUC Networks Inc.'s rate applications and was notified of the current application.
