**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. Ontario Energy Board File: EB-2022-0086
Dawn to Corunna Replacement Project
Response to Pollution Probe August 26, 2022 correspondence**

We are legal counsel for Enbridge Gas Inc. (“Enbridge Gas” or the “Applicant”) with respect to the above noted proceeding. This letter is in response to Pollution Probe’s August 26, 2022 letter requesting an extension of time to file its submissions in this matter and correspondingly an extension of Enbridge Gas’s reply submissions by nine days from the dates set out in Procedural Order No. 4.

Pollution Probe has premised its request on the fact that the OEB originally required CAPELA and Enbridge Gas to file a joint letter as to the status of their negotiations (the “Joint Letter”) on September 6 coinciding with the filing of Enbridge Gas’s argument in chief. The Joint Letter is to advise whether any outstanding issues have been settled and describing any agreement. In its letter of August 26, 2022, the OEB has since extended the timing for filing the Joint Letter to September 15, 2022. The corresponding extension requested by Pollution Probe is not appropriate and should not be granted.

According to Procedural Order No. 4, Enbridge Gas’s argument in chief is due September 6, 2022. CAPELA’s and all other intervenor submissions are due on September 20, 2022. Enbridge Gas’s argument in chief will deal with its current position related to the land agreements since it will not have the benefit of discussions with CAPELA at the time of filing. CAPELA’s and all other intervenor submissions are due on September 20, 2022. As a result, the filing of the Joint Letter on September 15 (five days before intervenor submissions are due) will provide sufficient time for CAPELA and other intervenors to reflect status of any agreement or outstanding issues described in the Joint Letter in their submissions together with a reply to any relevant submissions made by Enbridge Gas in its argument in chief. Enbridge Gas will be in a position to respond to those submissions on October 4, 2022. No party is prejudiced by the change in the filing date of the Joint Letter and, as such, Pollution Probe’s request should be denied.
