**EB-2022-0200 Enbridge 2024 Rebasing Application  
Pollution Probe Letter on Intervenor Evidence**

Pollution Probe is in receipt of letters dated today from Environmental Defence (ED), IGUA and BOMA related to Intervenor evidence proposed for the above noted proceeding. Pollution Probe recommends that the OEB approve these proposals as submitted. The issues outlined in the proposals specifically address issues relevant to this proceeding.
