## Re: Implementing the Process for Enabling Customers to Opt Into the Ultra-Low Overnight (ULO) Price Plan Ontario Energy Board File No. EB-2022-0160

Ontario Energy Board (OEB) staff would like to remind all licensed electricity distributors that they are required to notify the OEB in writing of the date on which the distributor began allowing eligible RPP consumers to elect to switch to the ULO price plan. That Notice must be provided no later than five business days after the distributor allows consumers to elect to do so. This notice requirement was set out in the OEB's <u>March</u> 21, 2023 letter.

Distributors are required to allow customers to elect to be charged the ULO price plan option starting November 1, 2023, as required by the Standard Supply Service Code. The last day for notice under the ULO transitional provisions is October 20, 2023.
