Re: EB-2023-0018 EPCOR Electricity Distribution Ontario Inc. Application for 2024 Rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) provided a draft Decision and Rate Order and a draft Tariff of Rates and Charges in relation to the above-noted proceeding on March 4, 2024. On March 6, 2024, in its comments on the drafts, EPCOR Electricity Distribution Ontario Inc. (EPCOR) submitted that the names given to the global adjustment rate rider in the above-referenced application and EPCOR's cost of service application (EB-2022-0020) are inconsistent, as set out below:

• EB-2022-0018:

Rate Rider for Disposition of Account 1589 Global Adjustment (2023) – effective until September 30, 2025 Applicable only for Non-RPP Class B Customers

• EB-2023-0018:

Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment (2024) – effective until April 30, 2025 Applicable only for Non-RPP Customers

EPCOR proposed the following naming convention as part of its 2024 tariff schedule:

 Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment Account (2024) – effective until XXXX XX, XXXX Applicable only for Non-RPP Class B Customers The OEB finds that the proposed change deviates from the current standard naming convention for the global adjustment rate rider. The OEB will keep the existing wording for EB-2023-0018 and take EPCOR's proposal into consideration for the following rate year. The OEB has now issued a final Decision and Rate Order, together with a final Tariff of Rates and Charges. Copies of these documents are enclosed with this letter.
