The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received Fort Albany First Nation's application for an electricity distribution licence on March 19, 2024. The OEB has commenced processing the application and has assigned it file number EB-2024-0119.

The application will be decided by an employee of the OEB who has been delegated this authority under section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (Delegated Authority). The Delegated Authority intends to make a decision on the application without holding a hearing.

If required, OEB staff will contact you directly to seek clarification regarding the application or to request additional information. Please note that the timely processing of the application depends on the receipt of information within the specified timelines.
