LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Patricia Squires:

Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) Application for an approval to construct natural gas pipelines in the City of Ottawa Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2024-0200

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas's application to construct natural gas pipelines in the City of Ottawa (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB in both online and hard copy newspapers, in accordance with directions to the OEB's media agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 to 3 below prior to **July 29, 2024**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at <u>registrar@oeb.ca</u>.

You are directed:

- 1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Enbridge Gas's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of the enclosed Notices and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:

- a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
- b. the clerk of the City of Ottawa
- c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
- d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Suite 1100 66 Slater Street, Ottawa, ON K1P 5H1
- e. all intervenors of record in EB-2019-0006 and EB-2020-0293
- f. all affected utilities and railway companies
- g. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- h. the following government ministries and entities:
 - i. Environment and Climate Change Canada
 - ii. Rideau Valley Conservation Authority
 - iii. National Capital Commission

(Note: It is acceptable to serve the evidence by e-mail provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)

- 3. To post the enclosed Notices, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, on Enbridge Gas's website.
- 4. To provide a copy of the Notices, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.
- 5. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the relevant Notices and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
