

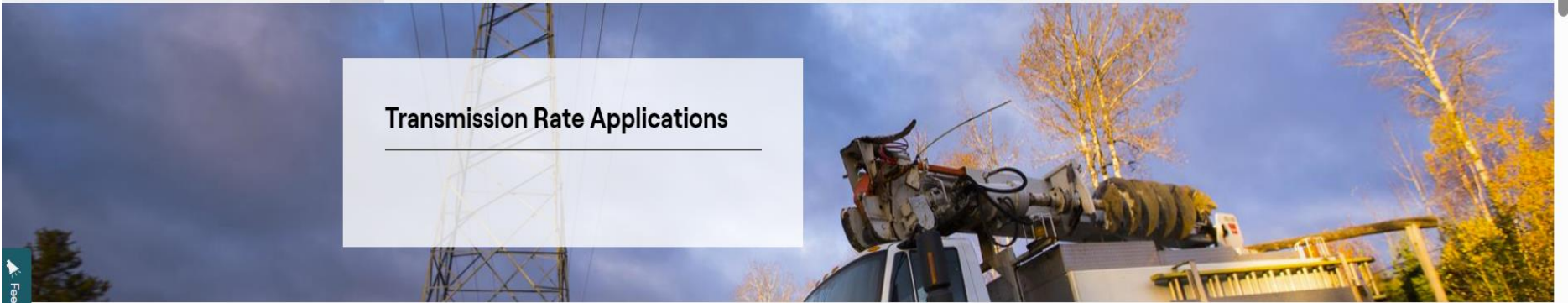



1 **APPLICATION**

2
3 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*,
4 S.O.1998, c.15 (Schedule B);

5
6 **AND IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by Hydro One
7 Networks Inc., for an Order or Orders made pursuant to section
8 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* approving rates and
9 other charges for the transmission of electricity to be effective
10 January 1, 2025.

- 12 1. The Applicant, Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One), is an Ontario corporation with
13 its head office in Toronto, Ontario. Hydro One is licensed by the Ontario Energy
14 Board (the OEB or the Board), under licence number ET-2003-0035, to transmit
15 electricity and carry on the business of owning and operating transmission facilities in
16 Ontario. The transmission business of Hydro One is referred to as “Hydro One
17 Transmission” in this Application.
 - 18
 - 19 2. In the OEB's Decision on Settlement Proposal and Order on Rates, Revenue
20 Requirement and Charge Determinants (Decision and Order) for Hydro One's
21 Custom Incentive Rate-setting (IR) Application (EB-2021-0110), the OEB approved
22 the proposed Custom IR methodology and determined that this framework would be
23 used to determine Hydro One's transmission revenue requirement for the years 2024
24 through to 2027 inclusive.¹
 - 25
 - 26 3. This is an Application for Hydro One's 2025 transmission revenue requirement
27 determined formulaically using the Custom IR methodology approved in EB-2021-
28 0110.

- 1 4. Hydro One Transmission hereby applies to the OEB for an Order approving a total
2 rates revenue requirement of \$2,135.6M for 2025, to be effective on January 1,
3 2025, and inclusion of Hydro One Transmission's approved rates revenue
4 requirement in the OEB's determination of the 2025 the Uniform Transmission Rates
5 (UTRs).
6
- 7 5. Hydro One is requesting approval to dispose of the balance in the Excess Export
8 Services Revenue Variance Account as of December 31, 2023 in the amount of
9 \$15,797,767 in this Application, as described in Exhibit A-04-01, Section 3.0.
10
- 11 6. Hydro One is requesting approval of the Export Transmission Service (ETS) rate of
12 \$1.86/MWh effective January 1, 2025, which has been updated by the Revenue Cap
13 Index (RCI) factor determined in this proceeding, as described in Exhibit A-04-01,
14 Section 4.
15
- 16 7. Approval of Hydro One Transmission's 2025 rates revenue requirement results in an
17 increase in the total bill of 0.59% or \$0.83 per month for a typical Hydro One
18 Distribution medium density residential (R1) customer consuming 750 kWh monthly
19 and an increase in total bill of 0.42% or \$1.84 per month for a typical Hydro One
20 Distribution General Service Energy less than 50 kW (GS<50kW) customer
21 consuming 2,000 kWh monthly. More information regarding the monthly bill impacts
22 may be found in Exhibit A-04-01, Section 6.
23
- 24 8. In preparing this Application, Hydro One has been guided by the OEB's *Filing*
25 *Requirements for Electricity Transmission Applications* dated February 11, 2016.
26
- 27 9. The written evidence filed with the OEB may be amended from time to time prior to
28 the OEB's final decision on the Application.

5 11. The persons affected by this Application are all persons affected by Ontario's UTRs.
6 It is therefore impractical to set out their names and addresses because they are too
7 numerous.

9 12. Hydro One requests, in accordance with sections 6(4) and 21(4)(b) of the *Ontario*
10 *Energy Board Act, 1998*, that this Application be disposed of without a hearing, and
11 hereby provides its consent to same. Hydro One submits that in accordance with the
12 requirements of section 21(4)(b) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, no person
13 will be adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of this proceeding.

15 **PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE**

16 13. Hydro One requests that the OEB's Rate Order be effective January 1, 2025. In
17 order to address the possibility that the requested Rate Order cannot be made
18 effective by that time, Hydro One requests an interim Rate Order making its current
19 transmission revenue requirement and charges effective on an interim basis as of
20 January 1, 2025, and approval to recover any differences between the interim rates
21 and final rates effective January 1, 2025 in the OEB's decision and order establishing
22 uniform transmission rates for the following year, based on the OEB's Decision and
23 Order herein.


