Re: **Alternative Price Plans for Non-RPP Class B Consumers**  
**Dynamic Pricing Options for Non-RPP Class B Electricity Consumers (EB-2022-0079)**

The OEB is developing alternative opt-in price plans for Class B consumers that are not eligible for Regulated Price Plan (RPP) prices. As part of this initiative, the OEB invited stakeholders to a meeting on September 9, 2024, to present its proposed designs and seek input from industry stakeholders. The [July 22, 2024, stakeholder meeting letter](#) invited stakeholders to provide written comments by October 4, 2024.

Following the stakeholder meeting on September 9, 2024, the OEB is sharing a list of questions and answers to further inform stakeholders as they prepare their written feedback.

In light of this additional material, the OEB is **extending the deadline** for written submissions to **October 10, 2024**.
