DECISION AND ORDER

Public Energy Gas Inc. (PEG) filed an application on August 28, 2024, with the OEB under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for a renewal of its electricity retailer licence ER-2019-0215, which is set to expire on November 6, 2024. The licence would allow the applicant to retail electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

PEG develops, owns, and operates natural gas-fired distributed energy resources, connected behind-the-meter, to supply electricity to large-volume industrial or commercial customers under retail contracts.

After considering the application and assessing the applicant's technical capability, financial viability, and conduct, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity retailer licence to Public Energy Gas Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for an electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
