AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE

I, **Tim Hesselink**, residing in the Town of Collingwood in the Province of Ontario, Canada make **OATH AND SAY as follows:**

1. I am employed as the Senior Manager, Regulatory Affairs for EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (“ENGLP”) and as such, I have knowledge of the matters deposed to herein.
2. On August 15, 2024, I filed with the Ontario Energy Board (the “**Board**”) ENGLP’s Limited Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“**CPCN**”) Application (the “**Application**”) to amend ENGLP’s existing CPCN to supply natural gas in the Municipality of Norfolk;
3. In accordance with the October 15, 2024 Letter of Direction issued by the Board, on October 18, 2024, I caused to be served by email a copy of the Notice of Hearing (the “**Notice**”) for ENGLP’s Application, the Application and the Evidence on the following parties as requested by the Board in the Letter of Direction:
 - a. Enbridge Gas Inc.
 - b. Clerk of Norfolk County

4. I am informed and verily believe that that ENGLP Staff served the Notice, Application and Evidence on Landowners at Concession 7, Lots 2 and 3, Norfolk County (excluding municipal address 220 and 230 8th Concession Road, in Norfolk County) on October 23 as follows:
 - a. By hand-delivery. Confirmation of delivery is included as **Exhibit "B"**, which is inclusive of email confirmations by ENGLP staff who participated in hand-delivery and which indicate the addresses to which they personally hand-delivered the Notice, Application and Evidence.
 - b. By Canada Post. Confirmation of shipment is included as **Exhibit "C"** which is inclusive of a list of addresses that received notices by mail correspondence and the Canada Post delivery confirmations which match the postal codes indicated in the list of addresses.

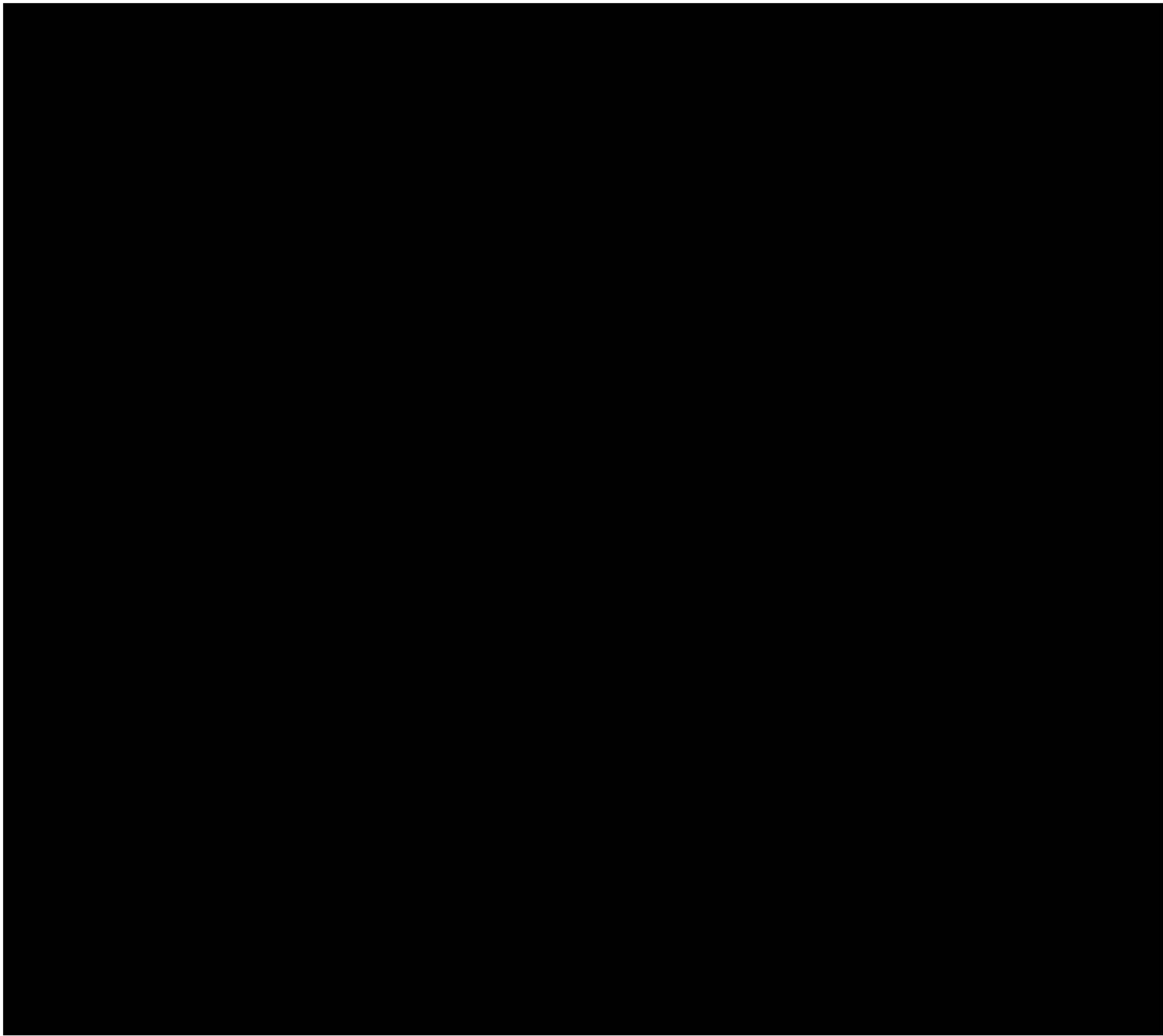

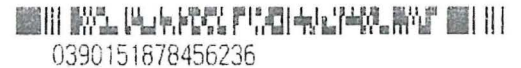



If you do not, the hearing will move forward without you, and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.


