Re: EB-2024-0309 – NT Power DVA Application – SEC Participation

We are counsel to the School Energy Coalition ("SEC"). SEC writes to inform the OEB and Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. ("NT Power") that it intends to participate in the proceeding. SEC was granted intervenor status and cost eligibility in NT Power's 2024 rate application (EB-2023-0039).
