INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Oakville Hydro Energy Services Inc. (Oakville Hydro) filed an application on March 11, 2025, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity generation licence.

Oakville Hydro's electricity generation licence EG-2004-0415 is set to expire on March 16, 2025. In order for the applicant to continue providing electricity generation services in Ontario, the applicant requires an electricity generation licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity generator, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The term of Oakville Hydro's electricity generation licence EG-2004-0415 is extended on an interim basis until May 14, 2025, or until the final determination of the electricity generation licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
