My concern is not with the technology, or the strategic planning behind this initiative, but with the communication in the call for participation. The email I received, and all of the materials provided in that email and accompanying materials have been drafted with complex language, terms that are not explained, and appear to be deliberately obtuse to reduce feedback and engagement on this application. I firmly believe that anything that requires public consultation should be drafted in plain language and, similar to existing bank document requirements, ensure that anyone with a grade seven reading ability would be able to review and understand. This is not the case here. I call on this group to pause, revise, and reissue these documents to ensure that the call for public feedback is meaningful and not performative and exclusionary.
